Directions

From the West on I-90

Canandaigua, Exit 44. 10 miles on Rte. 332 thru Canandaigua Business District (Main Street) to Rte 5&20. Turn right onto 5&20. Travel 1 mile on 5&20. Turn left onto Middle Cheshire Road. Go 4 miles. Turn left on Foster Road. Turn right at our sign.

From the East on I-90

Manchester Exit 43. Rte 21 south 12 miles to Rte 332 (Canandaigua's Main Street). Turn left onto Rte 332 and go thru business district to Rte 5&20. Turn right onto Rte 5&20. Turn left onto Middle Cheshire Road. Go 4 miles. Left on Foster Road. Turn right at our sign.

From the South (Naples)

Rte 21 north 14 miles to Wells Curtise Rd entering Cheshire. Right on Wells Curtise. 1/2 mile to Johnson Rd. Left 1/2 mile to Middle Cheshire Rd. Right on Foster Rd. Turn right at our sign.

From Corning and Hornell

Travel the Southern Tier Expressway (17) to Rte 390. Travel north on 390 to Exit 2 (Cohocton), at Exit 2, turn off onto the ramp towards Rte. 415 (Maple Ave.). Turn left onto Rte. 371 (N. Main St.). Continue to follow Rte. 371. 371 becomes Rte. 21 N. Turn right onto Wells Curtis Rd. Go about 1/4 mile. Turn left onto Johnson Rd. Go to the end and turn left onto Middle Cheshire Rd. go about 1/4 mile. Turn right onto Foster Rd. Notre Dame is the first right on Foster.

Fr. Mike Sergi, C.Ss.R. was born and raised in Baltimore, MD. and remains connected to his roots through his only sibling, a brother who lives with his wife and four children in Baltimore, MD.

Fr. Sergi received his education through the Redemptorist seminary system and was professed on August 1, 1972 and ordained on May 26, 1979. Fr, Sergi has served the Redemptorists in many capacities including:

- Associate pastor and pastor in Baltimore parishes
- Formation System—assisting newly ordained in transitioning to full time ministry
- “Missions” - preaching on behalf of the Redemptorists throughout Maryland, Washington DC and Virginia
- Rector and Director of St. John Neumann nursing home for Baltimore Province and currently is the Rector and director of Notre Dame Retreat House which provides twenty –one Retreat weekends per year for Parishioners within the Diocese of Rochester, New York.
